

Rules

1. No plaiting
2. Exhibitors may enter as many sections as they wish. However Judges will not wait for exhibitors if they are in another ring.
3. Your entry fee must accompany your entry or it will be returned.
4. The organisers will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be suffered by any exhibit, person or property, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold GraceBrook Equestrian Centre indemnified against any claim in respect of any accidental loss or damage. Exhibitors or owners signature on the entry form and or participation in the show denotes acceptance of these conditions.
5. No stallions 4 years or over permitted.
6. Youngstock – open to colt, fillies or geldings.
7. Colts over 6 months of age to be shown with bit in mouth, two and three years colts to have stallion badge on bridle.
8. Any horse/pony that may kick please indicate with red ribbon in tail.
9. Suitable heeled footwear must be worn.
10. 75% of entry fee will be refunded with a vet or doctor certificate provided it is received within 7 days of show date.
11. Competitors are expected to observe good manners and etiquette. Unnecessary rudeness may result in disqualification.
12. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving reason for doing so and reserve the right to alter, delete or combine classes as they see fit.
13. Class times are correct at time of printing the Schedule, however due to circumstances on day of show these times may change.
14. Children showing in Junior/Child handler classes must be 6 years old on day of show and not over 14 years. Suitable heeled footwear and hard hats advised. Ponies to be 14.2hh or under.
15. Please leave your dogs at home.
16. Classes will be combined if insufficient entries.
17. Judges may be subject to change.
