

General Rules and Information



1. All competitors, or trainees, when mounted must wear regulation crash helmets, and back protectors when jumping, conforming to current NZ safety Standards.
2. All competitors or trainees ride at their own risk. No responsibility is taken for any damage to or loss of personal property, accidents or injury to riders or horses, however every precaution is taken to avoid such incidents.
3. Management has the authority to evict or ban anyone whom they deem to be acting in an unacceptable manner.
4. Please report all accidents, regardless of how minor, to management.
5. Please report any damage to equipment or grounds, regardless if you are responsible for it or not, to management.
6. Please park in the allocated tie up parking area(s) as guided by management and ride/walk your mounts to your training area. The driveway speed limit is 20km; please be very aware of riders, children and other traffic.
7. Dogs are permitted, but must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your dog(s). We reserve the right to request your dog be put in your car if it becomes a danger/annoyance to others.
8. Please state what height you will be training at on the Admission Form to receive your appropriate course map. Please follow the colour code as specified.
9. Please use the Port-a-loos provided on GraceBrook grounds. Under no circumstances are you, or those with you, to approach Brew Moon café for use of their toilets, unless you are a patron there.
10. Yards and a Roundring are available for your convenience. Please show consideration to others using our grounds who may need to use yards or the Roundring also, by removing your belongings and leaving the yards clean. Horse manure can be left in the barrows provided.
11. There are two Wash down areas, one next to the yards by the Arena, the other by the Roundring yards. Please make sure to leave these areas in a clean and considerate state for other users.
12. Stallions are not permitted on the grounds without prior arrangement.
13. Please be aware of a variety of hazards on the property. Electric fences, unfenced waterways, uneven ground, beehives, clothesline, pinecones, tree roots, low lying branches, sticks on the ground, stones or rocks, rabbit holes, other riders, and when wet a lot of the areas can be slippery. Please also note that Dr Watson, the resident beagle, may pop out suddenly on the trail of a bunny.
14. Riders under the age of sixteen must have parental consent and their parent/guardian must sign the Admission Form.
15. When riding the Bridle Path, please stick to the track provided. At the jump you may leave the track to go around it if you prefer, but that is the only place it is safe for you to leave the track.
16. For your safety, management reserves the right to close areas.
17. In the event of an accident there is a First Aid Kit at the shop as shown on the layout map. If the accident is serious to the rider please call 111, and ask for an ambulance to 156 Ashworths Road, Amberley. If the accident is serious to the horse please call Mike Brown, a mobile emergency vet on 0274-324-982.
18. When riding or walking up to the cross-country course from the parking area, please refrain from riding or walking on the grass verges.
19. The shop sells water and soft drinks.
20. The river is available to ride down to the beach, please check with your layout map for appropriate gate to leave the property through. Please note that this is not part of the GraceBrook grounds and therefore not maintained for safety.
21. Please take your rubbish away with you, we do not supply rubbish bins or rubbish collectors.
